Notation Once to self

A (8 bars)	Foot Up 4/3 step with 4 upright capers	
A	Repeat with singing	
B	Chorus	All figures with 4 plain capers
A	Whole-Hey	
B	Chorus	Chorus (weeping and 1/2 hey) 2X
A	Cross-Over	
B	Chorus	
A	Back to Back	
B	Chorus	
A	Whole-Hey in All in	

CHORUS

Weeping to right with singing (4 bars)
Weeping to left with singing (4 bars)
4/3 stepping with capers singing

The weeping movement is a bend to the right [] bringing the the handkerchiefs up
to the eyes in a gesture of weeping.
