

QUEEN ANNE'S STATUE IN QUEEN'S SQUARE



Queen's Square, later renamed Queen Anne's Square, and now known as Queen's Gate was built in the first decade of the 18th century. Later it became part of the estate of Sir Theodore Jansen, one of the directors of The South Sea Company, and was sold when the "Bubble" burst. Queen's Square consisted of two streets forming two sides of a square the other sides being Broadway and Carteret Street.
